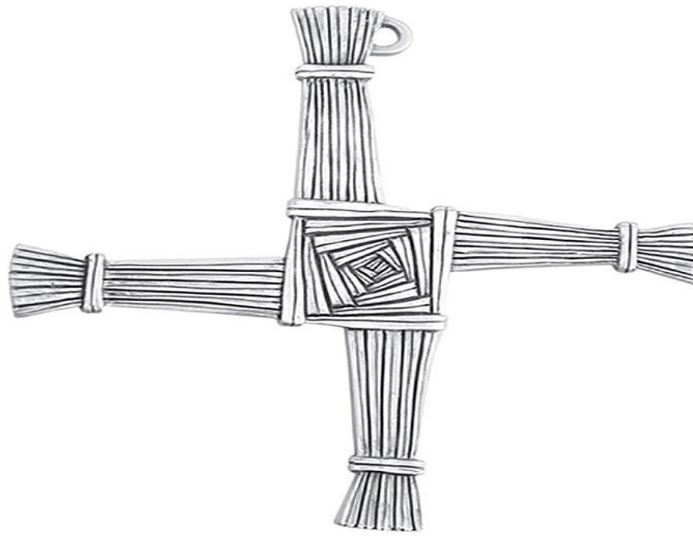

Weekly Reflection.

Saint Brigid

A poem of welcome for Saint Brigid, composed by the late Fr. Tom Hamill sums up many of her attributes. In a shortened form, Fr. Hamill's 'Thirteen shouts for Saint Brigid' reads: Brigid, you usher in the spring. You welcome all who visit. You guard our families and flocks. You shelter the poor in your cloak. You inspire singers and writers. You strengthen workers in metal. You guide the hands of healers. You soften the hate that divides us. You cherish what comes to birth. You mirror Jesus in your life. You bless our wells and streams. You smile in sea and sky. You embrace us deep in your heart.

The public holiday (on Monday, 2nd February 2026) is linked with the feast of our patron saint. It was established as a recognition of the enormous sacrifices made by our people and by front-line workers in particular during the Covid 19 pandemic. With Saint Brigid we remember those who died, all who suffered in so many ways, and those who still suffer, and we express our gratitude to those who, like Saint Brigid, gave guidance, care, and comfort.

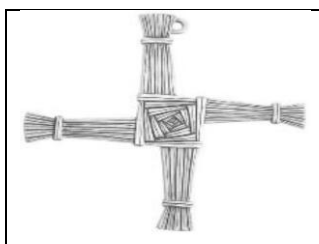

Trees at St Joseph's Church Carrickmacross and at St John's Church Raferagh.

I have been concerned about the condition of the trees at both Churches for some time. They are enormous trees and are not in a great condition and with the increase in numbers and ferocity of storms we need to address the issue. Chambers Tree surgeons carried out the removal of trees in Corduff following storm Éowyn last year, following the falling of around fifteen trees there. We have also witnessed the destruction caused in that storm to the Paupers Graveyard on the Donaghmoyne Road, when a large number of trees were uprooted. I would appreciate if anyone who has strong opinions on this issue to speak to either myself or Fr. McEaney, or to any member of the Parish Finance team, so that a decision can be made. Options would appear to be to do nothing, to remove the trees, or to reduce the height and width of the trees significantly.
