Weekly Reflection.

"Praying for the Dead"

Belief in the Resurrection of the dead is an essential part of our Faith. This implies that our earthly existence is only one stage of our journey towards God. Death is a natural passage for all humanity and those of us who believe look forward to this moment as being not the end of everything but the beginning of the next phase of our existence. "For your faithful people Lord, life is changed not ended."

The Church believes that we can assist the souls of our brothers and sisters on this journey as we pray for God's forgiveness and a welcome into his Kingdom. The Church has always been convinced of this "it is a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed of their sins."

Today and in this month of November we pray especially for deceased members of our families and of our communities, and we offer celebrations of the Eucharist for the dead whose names occur on the November Dead Lists.
