### **Weekly Reflection.**

**'You are the light of the world.'**

Many of you will agree with me when I say that we are living in a world which is fractured if not completely broken, in terms of the chaos which envelops us. Public discourse at international level has become crude and vulgar, where might is right and where the influence of bodies such as the UN have been pushed to the margins as their voices of calm diplomacy are overwhelmed by the angry shouts of hatred and revenge.

When values of morality and decency and integrity are sidelined, where ridicule takes the place of respectful interaction, many may determine that the only way to survive is to become brash, abrasive, and self-centred.

The Catholic Church approach to this distortion is to rediscover compassion and courage and without naivete to present its traditions and culture as an antidote to the negativity of individuality that eats away at our sense of community and belonging.

The Church for all its failings, and indeed because of its failings, speaks not from a position of moral superiority, but from a position where its repentance acknowledges human weakness, and points to redemption based on accountability. In this moment, the Catholic Church is once more capable of being the light to the world that gives meaning and hope and prophetic vision to all people. This vision speaks of creation as a gift, human beings as inherently dignified, and our vocation to treat all our brothers and sisters with love and respect.

You and I can be the light of the world.

## **Trees at St Joseph's Church Carrickmacross and at St John's Church Raferagh.**

I have been concerned about the condition of the trees at both Churches for some time. They are enormous trees and are not in a great condition and with the increase in numbers and ferocity of storms we need to address the issue. Chambers Tree surgeons carried out the removal of trees in Corduff following storm Éowyn last year, following the falling of around fifteen trees there. We have also witnessed the destruction caused in that storm to the Paupers Graveyard on the Donaghmoyne Road, when a large number of trees were uprooted. I would appreciate if anyone who has strong opinions on this issue to speak to either myself or Fr. McEneaney, or to any member of the Parish Finance team, so that a decision can be made. Options would appear to be to do nothing, to remove the trees, or to reduce the height and width of the trees significantly.
